

CANFORD SCHOOL, DORSET

Brief Description

Canford School is an early-mid 19th Century Building and is Grade I listed. It became a school in 1923. In the grounds, a Norman church and the 14th Century John O'Gaunt's kitchen survive and are used by the school.

The main building forms the nucleus of the school but there are a number of more modern buildings built as the school's requirements increased.
